EPiC ABCs

Aimed at children and parents to improve the children's co-ordination. This helps in the long run for them to pick up squash quickly from a toddler age.

EPiC Toddlers

This is perfect for children to start improving their co-ordination and ability to start rallying in squash. This type of session will introduce children to a squash court and learning all of the basic skills to be able to balance the ball and start hitting FH and BH shots correctly.

EPiC Belters

This session is aimed at children who can hold a rally in pairs and individually be able to hit 5 shots on the FH and BH side. The ball that we use in this group is between the yellow / pink ball and the orange ball.

EPiC Lobbers

For children who may be new to the game and slightly older than the age range, or within the age range and have played a little before. The ball used in the group is between an orange ball and a red dot ball.

EPiC Boasters

This session is aimed at children who have played before. They will be using a red dot ball and would need to be able to serve and return.

EPiC Improvers

For children who have played a reasonable amount before; can do routines and conditioned games and know the rules of squash and be able to compete with a single yellow dot ball.

EPiC Pros

Aimed at children who have played a reasonable amount before. Can do routines and conditioned games and know the rules of squash and be able to compete with a double yellow dot ball.

EPiC Girls

A female only session. This is aimed at increasing female participation, Suitable for all ages and abilities.

EPiC Performance - Invitation Only Session

A performance programme aimed towards players playing at a minimum level of county standard and aspire to compete for the Midlands and England.

Privacy Notice

Who are we?

Edgbaston Priory Club, Sir Harry's Road, Edgbaston, B15 2UZ is a private members' club offering tennis, squash, lifestyle, food, beverage and events facilities.

Your personal data:

Personal data is any information which identifies you as a living individual. This may include name, address, phone numbers, email addresses, date of birth, photographs and CCTV images.

How do we process your personal data?

The privacy of your personal data is very important to us. The Club complies with its obligations under the General Data Protection Regulation by keeping personal data up to date; by storing and destroying it securely; protecting personal data from loss, misuse, unauthorised access or disclosure.

On enrolment on the course, the following personal data is collected.

- The Parent/Guardian's personal data (Name, address, email address, telephone number)
- Name and date of birth of Junior
- Photograph for identification purposes
- Financial data to process payment
- Medical and dietary needs
- Emergency contact details

This data is required in order to successfully administer the course, inform you of course cancellations and to contact you in the event of an emergency.

We will seek consent to communicate with course participants regarding future courses, events and special offers. If you agree to receiving marketing communications from us you are able to change your mind at any time by unsubscribing or by informing us by email or by phone. However, if you do not opt in to receive marketing communications, you may not hear about events and offers that may be of interest to you.

Sharing your personal data

Your personal data will be treated as strictly confidential and will only be shared with EPC coaches running the course that you are signing up to in order to take registers and make awards.

We will never give out your information to third parties. The Lawn Tennis Association and England Squash are only given aggregate data and no personal data is provided to them.

How long do we keep your personal data?

Enrollee details are retained for one term and then destroyed if renewals do not occur. Registers are printed for coaches on the day of a course session. These are kept by the coaches at all times and are destroyed on the same day of use.

Your rights and personal data

Unless subject to an exemption under the 'GDPR', you have the following rights with respect to your personal data: -

The right to request a copy of your personal data which the Club holds about you,

- The right to request that Edgbaston Priory Club corrects any personal data if it is found to be inaccurate or out of date,
- The right to request your personal data is erased where it is no longer necessary for the Club to retain such data,
- The right to withdraw your consent to the processing at any time,
- The right to request that the data controller provide the data subject with his/her personal data and where possible, to transmit that data directly to another data controller, (known as the right to data portability), (where applicable)
- The right, where there is a dispute in relation to the accuracy or processing of your personal data, to request a restriction is placed on further processing,
- The right to object to the processing of personal data, (where applicable)
- The right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Manager,

Course Terms & Conditions

1) Payment is due on a termly basis and the application form and payment must be received at least one week before the term starts so that we can ensure suitable coach cover and inform you if the course is still available.

2) There are no refunds for missed sessions however caused (except outdoor rained off sessions where we will endeavour to catch up by using the spare weeks at the end of each course first).

3) Players must turn up in suitable attire as per the EPC Clothing & Footwear Rules - failure to comply will result in the player not being permitted to play.

4) EPC reserves the right to offer a more suitable course if the player is not up to the standard of the course they have applied for.

5) EPC reserves the right to cancel a course if there are insufficient numbers attending giving 48 hours notice of this intent.

6) Players are encouraged to arrive early and undertake a general physical warm up so that they are ready for their session and so that we can start promptly. Physical warm ups will not be done during the session time.

7) Parents/guardians must return to collect their child five minutes before the end of the session. Coaches are not responsible for the child once the session has finished and under 10s are not permitted to be left unattended or expected to make their own way to the clubhouse.

8) Non-members may attend EPC courses but they must pay the appropriate rate. Members take precedence over non-members if there is excess demand. Non-members are not permitted to use any of the club's facilities.

8) EPC Staff will not be liable for any injury, Clients & Participants agree that First Aid may be administered by a qualified First Aider where necessary, without prior consent.
